Free for Medicaid Providers

KFMC and KDHE's Division of Health Care Finance (KDHE/DHCF) are working together to assist Medicaid healthcare providers with health information technology.

Services offered include:

- EHR Selection and Implementation Assistance
- Promoting Interoperability (formerly Meaningful Use) Assistance
- Privacy and Security Risk Assessment and Mitigation
- Privacy & Security Policies & Procedures Development, Review, and Updating
- Process Analysis and Redesign
- Health IT support

You are eligible for free services if the following statements are true.

1. I am contracted with at least one of the three managed care organizations (United Healthcare, Sunflower, Amerigroup) as a Medicaid provider **OR** I have a Kansas Medical Assistance Program (KMAP) Fee-for-Service number.
2. I am a physician (MD, DO), nurse practitioner, nurse midwife, or dentist.
3. Less than 90% of my services are performed in a hospital inpatient or emergency room setting (Place of Service codes 21 or 23).
