Oral Cancer Risk Profile

- . Increased risk
 - Patients age 40 and older (95% of all cases)
 - 18-39 years of age combined with the following:
 - Tobacco use
 - Chronic alcohol consumption
 - Oral HPV infection
- . Highest risk
- . Patients age 65 and older with lifestyle risk factors
- . Patients with history of oral cancer
