Course Description:

This course will help the participant identify common oral diseases as well as oral soft and hard tissue lesions. It will focus on the etiology, radiographic and histologic manifestations as well as prognosis and treatment options. Clinical Pathologic Case Presentation (CPC) will also be discussed.

Course Objectives:

To achieve competency and confidence in the diagnosis of oral lesions and diseases. Participants will know how to recognize specific oral lesions, interpret clinical signs and symptoms and formulate a differential diagnosis, and understand the therapeutic approach to treat and manage oral diseases and lesions.

BIO: Guenter Jonke, DMD earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Biology at SUNY Stony Brook University. He continued his studies at C.W. Post College, Greenvale, NY where he earned his Master's Degree in Microbiology. In 1988, he completed his requirements to earn his Doctor of Dental Medicine degree at Boston University School of Dental Medicine. At the prestigious Georgetown University in Washington D.C. he completed his hospital-based specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial surgery. He is Board Certified in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and has been in private practice since 1991.

In addition, he enjoys teaching and is a clinical assistant instructor at the Dental School located at SUNY Stony Brook. For many years he has volunteered his time with the dental residents at St. Charles Hospital located in Port Jefferson, New York.

He lectures numerous on a variety of topics including dental implants, bone grafting, and oral pathology, and was the leader of the Smithtown Study Club for 15 years. He is committed to organized dentistry involving the Suffolk County Dental Society representing fellow dentists over a wide array of issues.
