Learning Objectives: “To Pull or Not to Pull” • Be able to differentiate between an Endo/Perio vs. Perio/Endo lesions and understand the difference as it relates to a long term prognosis • Know when it is NOT ideal to remove a tooth and replace with an implant • Recognize how the location of a sinus tract can be a key critical diagnostic indicator for the long term prognosis • Incorporate a simple radiographic technique to use when evaluating a tooth for a fracture • Understand the principles of guided tissue regeneration, and know the indications and contraindications for its use with Endo/Perio lesions • Appreciate how the use of a surgical guide can significantly reduce complications. ie minimizing Perimplantitis and Early Crestal Bone loss • Learn the statistical difference for the long term Prognosis of Root Canal Treatment vs. Apical Surgery vs. Removal and Implant Placement • Become aware that many long held and generally accepted principles over time do not always hold up (and others do) ie: Long term prognosis for Hemi-sected teeth, Teeth with 50% bone loss maintained indefinitely. • AND MORE!

BIO: After graduating from New York University College of Dentistry in 1978, Dr. Daniel G. Pompa completed a General Practice Residency at Long Island Jewish Hospital, followed by specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Lincoln Hospital, New York Medical College. In 1982, he became a Fellow of The American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons and in 1992 a Fellow in The International Congress of Oral Implantologists.
