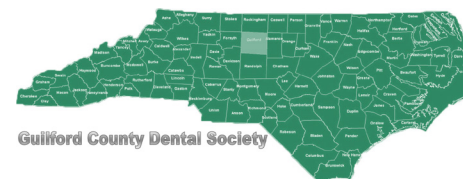

### **Morning Program *Antibiotics in Dentistry***

#### Educational Objectives

- 1) Develop Algorithms for Selecting Antibiotics for Localized and Spreading Infections and for Antibiotic Prophylaxis
- 2) Understand the subtleties of the AHA “Guidelines” and the Inconsistencies of the 2015 ADA vs. the 2012 AAOS Prosthetic Joint Recommendations

Mother, Immunosuppressive Therapy and Diabetes Mellitus affect Antibiotic Selection This course will discuss the changing antibiotic options in dentistry for acute infections and prophylaxis for old and new antibiotic categories and formulations. The current American Heart Association at-risk patients and the inconsistencies for the 2015 ADA vs. the 2012 Orthopedic Surgeons’ recommendations will be discussed. What is recommended for patients already on, or recently on an antibiotic? New data and designs dictate a new approach to cardiac and vascular stents. What is the bottom line on prophylaxis for vascular repairs, the four approaches to renal dialysis, IVC Filters, Hickman catheters, Portacaths and the VA vs. VP hydrocephalus shunts. What medical conditions affect antibiotic selection?

#### ***Treating Periodontitis & Peri-Implantitis: The Good, The Bad & The Ugly***

#### Educational Objectives

- 1) Learn the Clinical “Pearls” that Maximize Success
- 2) Recognize and Avoid “The High Risk Failure” Cases
- 3) Save Many More Teeth and Implants than You Thought You Could
- 4) Improve Dental Treatment Planning with Evidence Based Data

What must we know chairside every day to successfully treat periodontitis in both the compliant and non-compliant patient? Do the same principles to peri-implantitis? How do we treatment plan a choice between periodontally compromised teeth, crown and bridge, replacements or implants? Understand the “Evidence Based Data” in the dental literature compared to the “Promotional Dentistry” of the manufacturers. Does the soft tissue program in the dental office influence this decision? Which cases are the winners and losers? What medical issues increase risk for dental failure? Learn specific protocols from cures to toothbrushes, antibiotics to analgesics, medical disease and drugs, to mouth rinses and toothpaste.

### **Biographical Sketch**

Dr. Fazio is an honors graduate of Harvard College and Harvard School of Dental Medicine who also completed clinical fellowships in periodontology and oral medicine at Harvard. For 39 years he maintained a private practice limited to oral medicine, implants and periodontology in Norwalk, CT. “DENTISTRY TODAY” has named Dr. Fazio as one of the “Top 100 Clinicians In Continuing Education” for eleven consecutive years. His most current book, co-authored with Doctor Leslie Fang, is the 2017 Edition of The Ultimate Cheat Sheets - The Practical Guide for Dentists. It was named “Best Educational Product” by Gordon Christensen’s CRA Newsletter for three consecutive years. His other books include Oral Medicine Secrets and Principles and Practice of Oral Medicine. The CRA Newsletter also named Dr. Fazio’s “Antibiotics in Dentistry” DVD the “best education product of 2003.” Dr. Fazio has been named a leader in continuing education by Dentistry Today since 2008.
