However, an individual appointed to complete a term of less than two years is eligible for an appointment of four years to any agency to which the district or the Board has a scheduled appointment.

\*\* The House of Delegates strongly urged the Board to consider that the four members of CODA nominated by the ADA Board be general dentists from active, life or retired members of the ADA. In response to resolution 76H-2010, new CODA appointees will be identified one year in advance of their term of service to participate in CODA activities. **The individual selected this year will become the 2018-designate to CODA.**
